

Behavior Plan 2018-19
MUSIC- Intermediate

Discipline plan:

These will be discussed in class.

The basic Music classroom rules are:

- I will quietly listen and follow directions.
- I will respect others and the instruments.
- I will participate and do my best.

Consequences:

1. Student will receive a verbal or gestured warning.
2. At the second warning the student will be given an opportunity to correct their action by stating the procedure they are not doing and then they will demonstrate the correct procedure.
3. The third warning receives a timeout in the music room where the student will sit away from the group but still engaged in the lesson. If sharing an instrument, their partner will continue to use the instrument. After 5 minutes the student can return to the group when they agree that they can correct the behavior.
4. The fourth warning the student receives a Behavior Report from the Music room slip that goes to the classroom teacher to be put in the student's planner for the parents to sign. The student will also "clip down" on their behavior chart in the homeroom classroom. There is an accompanying notice to clip down notify the teacher.

Consistent errant behavior will be reflected on an interim report. If necessary, a parent conference to discuss strategies for behavior modification will be arranged.

Extreme behavior may require skipping some steps and/or an administrator will remove the student and handle the situation after a Student Discipline Referral is filled out.

Rewards:

1. Individual daily praise.
2. Class praise.
Outstanding students may "clip up" on their behavior chart in their homeroom. There is an accompanying notice to "clip up" to notify the teacher.
3. Teacher will reward classes with *points* from the clip chart at the end of the lesson.

Based on the seven level clip chart- Classes start at Ready to Learn and move up or down depending on behavior and lesson engagement.

At the end of each nine-week period the class/classes that collects the most points in each grade level will earn a certificate that their teacher displays. The class(es) that earn their points for all four nine weeks will receive a special reward.
