
Instructional Focus

Language Arts-

Our Instructional focus for Language Arts for the first full week of May is strategy: reread and skill: problem and solution. The second week of May we will focus on the strategy: reread and the skill: Compare and Contrast. The final week of reading will focus on the strategy: point of view and the literary elements: rhythm and rhyme.

Math- Areas of math that we will be covering this last month of school are model tenths and hundredths, fractions greater than one, equivalent fractions, equivalent fractions on a multiplication table, same size, same shape, change customary units of length, change metric units of length, estimate and measure liquid volume, and estimate and measure weight. We will continue our multiplication fact review or division review, depending on your child's pro-
