VHS Early College

The Villages High School is an Early College campus of Lake Sumter State College.

VHS offers 27 college courses on its campus. In 2023-2024 there are 208 VHS students, 19.1% of the VHS student body, taking at least one dual enrollment college class. VHS students are taking a cumulative 3,364 college credit hours in 2023-2024.
