

Mrs. Cree's Gifted Class Grading Policy - 2017-2018



GRADING POLICY:

The Gifted class is listed as “Advanced Academics - Cree” in Skyward for progress reports and report cards for students in grades K-3. The student’s grade will show as a percentage. Participation counts as 70% of the overall grade, Math and/or ELA assignments count as 20% and classwork counts as the remaining 10%. Students at the Primary Center (grades Kindergarten and 1st grade) will be graded on a Standards-Based scale. There is also a separate grade for Conduct. The results of the classroom behavior plan determine how conduct in our classroom is earned.



CONDUCT GRADES:

Conduct Grades are earned based on points received during the nine week grading period in the Gifted Education classroom. The chart below explains the point values and Conduct grades. Please note, if students receive more than three “correctional” notes home in the 9 week grading period, conduct will be an N.

REWARDS for the GIFTED CLASS

Students will receive points based on their ending spot on the Gifted classroom clip chart each day. Students will each have a Points page to record their points at the end of every week. Rewards are earned according to the number of points. Students will be allowed to redeem points for rewards every two weeks or they may choose to “bank” their rewards and save for a larger reward.
