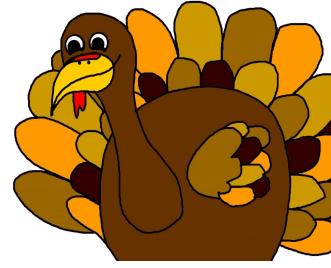

Important November Dates!

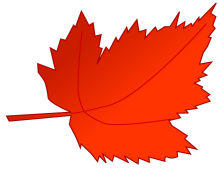
November 1st	All donations for Basket Auction should be in Buffalo Pride (6:00PM @ VCMS Gym)

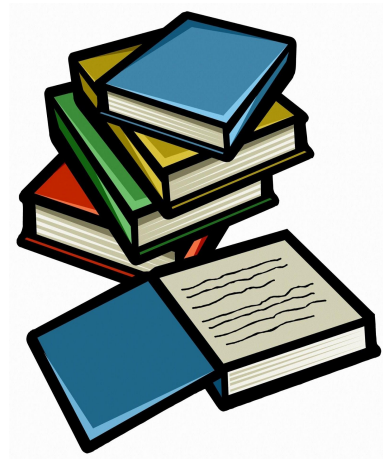
Curriculum Focus
