## **Course Overview**

This course serves as a companion to The Villages High School Color Guard. This class focuses on skills and knowledge involved in the performance and choreography of the performance art. Students will study a variety of topics which will enhance their understanding and mastery of eurhythmics.

- Critique
- Solo work
- Ensemble work

## **Methodology**

Eurhythmics students will be instructed in a variety of methods, including, but not limited to:

- full ensemble
- one on one
- groups
- class discussion
- group work & group presentations
- individual work & individual presentations

## **Grading**

  - Bellringer (in class with equipment ready by teacher designated time)
  - Class participation (active role in all class activities, cooperation with teacher and peers, adherence to all class policies in the students contract)
